FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST REFERENCE NO: 01/FOI/26/016705/R

I write in connection with your request for information dated 14/04/2026, received by Greater Manchester Police (GMP) for the following information:

I am aware a misconduct hearing was heard on 09/03/2 regarding [REDACTED] Neil Wood. Subsequently following that hearing no finding or papers were published and no mention of this case has been made on misconduct outcomes and narrative has been published. The only reference to the case was a note saying a final written warning was given.

I wish to see the copy of the hearing as per all other public misconduct hearing and wish to see any relevant information and discussions as to why this hearing has not been published as pre the vast majority of other misconduct hearings.

Result of Searches

Following receipt of your request searches were conducted within Greater Manchester Police (GMP) to locate the requested information and I can confirm the information requested is held by GMP.

However, I am not obliged to supply the information you have requested as exemptions apply.

When refusing to provide such information because an exemption applies, Section 17(1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 requires GMP, to provide you - the applicant - with a notice which: (a) states that fact, (b) specifies the exemption in question and (c) states (if that would not otherwise be apparent) why the exemption applies.
