Date	Rank	Allegation	Misconduct Meeting or Gross Misconduct Hearing	Outcome
16/04/20	Former Constable	The officer lied to his supervision about why he could not attend for duty. He continued with the lie after being challenged about the account.	Special Case Hearing	Found proven as Gross misconduct but No further action as the officers would not have been dismissed is still serving.
30/04/20	Constable	The officer was convicted of driving with excess alcohol in his breath whilst off duty.	Special Case hearing	Found Proven as Gross Misconduct – Final Written Warning issued
12/05/20	Constable	The officer was convicted of driving with excess alcohol in his breath whilst off duty.	Special Case Hearing	Officer dismissed without notice
28/05/20	Former Constable	The officer tested positive for steroids on a GMP with cause drug test	Special Case Hearing	Found proven a Gross misconduct – disciplinary action imposed. Meaning the officer would have been dismissed if still serving in GMP
28/05/20	Constable	The officer tested positive for steroids on a GMP with cause drug test	Special Case Hearing	Officer dismissed without notice
02/06/20	Former Assistant Chief Constable	The officer's entries in their firearms commanders log were not accurate and as a result were misleading. The officer initially failed to mention at a subsequent public enquiry that the entries had been made retrospectively.	Hearing	Allegations withdrawn during the hearing
25/06/20	Police staff	The member of staff took hold of a colleagues arm causing injury and used inappropriate language	Meeting	Found not proven
