Notice is hereby given that the Appointed Auditor, Mark Dalton, on behalf of Mazars LLP, has concluded the audit of the Statement of Accounts of the Chief Constable of Greater Manchester Police for the financial year 2019/20 in accordance with the Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014 and the National Audit Office's Code of Audit Practice. An unqualified audit opinion has been provided on the accounts.

- the auditor's opinion on the statement of accounts;
- any public interest report relating to the Chief Constable or an entity connected with it;
- any recommendation relating to the Chief Constable or an entity connected with it
